## What/who is on the Ballot this November 5?

### **Each vote counts!**

Grass Lake Township Precinct 3 (the Village) sample ballot is available online now at https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/PublicBallot/Index and it includes wording for all the referendums as well — Jackson District Library millage renewal proposal, Jackson College millage proposal, and County of Jackson jail operations millage question.

And, there are choices to be made. Within our Township alone, four Trustee positions

for the Township Board are on the ballot (with 5 candidates), along with three Trustee positions on the Village of Grass Lake Council (with 5 candidates), and three local school board members for Grass Lake Community Schools (with 9 candidates).

Five positions in the Township have single candidates running unopposed.


This ballot offers eight possibilities from which to pick one choice for US President.

It is a large ballot, and gratefully there is at least one name listed for each elected po-

sition such as for County Prosecutor or Sherriff. Those races were really decided at Primary time last August.

Still, if you do not know who the people listed are, then your vote could be less beneficial for you. Learning about those running in advance of casting your ballot is a good thing. Vote411 is one of many websites that lists candidates and lets you compare their answers to a series of questions asked.

On Thursday, October 10, consider attending an event at the Grass Lake Events Pavilion to "**Meet the Candidates**" and ask them questions. Many your fellow citizens running for local offices will be there from 6-8 pm as well as some running for County wide positions.
