A dedicated group of local volunteers gathered in late October to make certain that a Grass Lake tradition since 2007 would still take place this year. **Festival of Lights** is held on the first Saturday of December, and includes fun all day that begins with an 8 am Breakfast with Santa at the Firehouse at 12222 E Michigan Ave, includes a craft mart, the cookie tour, tree walk, and culminates with a fully-lit parade at 6:30 pm with Santa on the last float—and then he lights the Historic Whistlestop Depot's Christmas tree.

Look for the flyers and social media reports. As you enjoy the festivities, give thanks for the countless hours of work it took to put together a full day of fun for children and adults alike. With a mere 5½ weeks to prepare, this really qualifies as a miracle on Michigan Avenue.

Forward progress...

The Downtown Development Authority's role is to reduce blight and deterioration, with the end impact being economic growth and higher property values. The DDA is addressing these objectives in several ways. Its first priority is to bring new businesses downtown - ideally local entrepreneurs with a passion for community. We are very fortunate to have four "Mom & Pop" type businesses in the works. Cattleman's Coffee and Provisions (was Roaming Goat) is expected to open in December; Asher Creek (was Jams) is a proposed deli and creamery planned for 2024; Prates Place (was Ryan's) will be a family-oriented restaurant/bar with a focus on community (plans for breakfasts, at least on the weekends); and a Chelsea chef/baker/sommelier plans to open a yet-to-be-named bakery/cafe (was Muscle And Soul) to open in mid-2024. The DDA just received very positive feedback in a preliminary assessment about the viability of creating a historic district in the downtown.

Budget Workshop Meetings Recap

The budget process is ongoing. Sections of the first draft were discussed at the November 14 Budget workshop, the first of four planned sessions for Council to have open discussion about line items — sewer, water, equipment pool, general fund, etc. The first workshop focused on Salaries and General Fund.

Nothing replaces being in the room to hear the questions and answers that explain the funds and the logic behind proposed figures. Discussions included the proposed salary increases for cost of living, and for required education. State law requires the Village to employ two certified, water quality officials. The village needs to retain its knowledgeable staff.

The General Fund balance has decreased in the last few years to a point of concern. Improved management with forecasts toward replacing assets simply means that money is being saved each year toward future planned expenditures.

The November 21 workshop focused on Major and Local Streets financing; lively discussion did not allow covering more. The next Workshop is scheduled for Dec 5, at 6 pm, before the regular Council meeting at 7 pm.

A public hearing will be held in February

2024, before the final proposed budget is voted on by Council. The new budget takes effect March 1. What the public reviews at that time is the result of several months of research and discussion to achieve the best balanced budget for the new year. Now is the time to contact the Village Manager and Council members over any personal concerns.



Message in a Bottle

In 2024, a new spacecraft will hurtle toward Jupiter in a bid to learn whether its moon Europa is capable of supporting life. Along with hightech sensors, it also will carry a poem and hundreds of thousands of human names. Yours could be one of them because NASA is asking people to submit their names by the end of 2023, ahead of the mission's October 2024 launch.

You can join the mission and have your name engraved on NASA's Europa Clipper spacecraft as it travels 1.8 billion miles to explore Europa, an ocean world that may support life. Visit MESSAGE IN A BOTTLE. https://europa.nasa.gov/message-in-a-bottle/sign-on/. The Europa Clipper spacecraft should enter Jupiter's orbit in 2030.
