V. APPLICANT SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the state construction code of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. Violators of section 23a are subjected to civil fines.

IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.**

When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing at least 24 hours advance notice. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.** The building official is authorized to grant an extension of the permit for 180 days. The extension shall be requested in writing and justifiable cause demonstrated. A maximum of two extensions are allowed, A \$60 fee will be assessed for the first extension and a fee half of the original permit cost for the second extension.
